

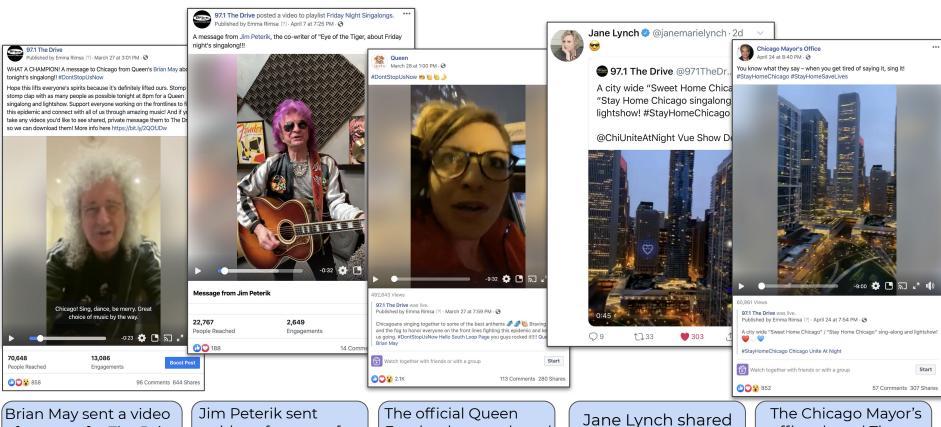
FRIDAY NIGHT SING-ALONGS

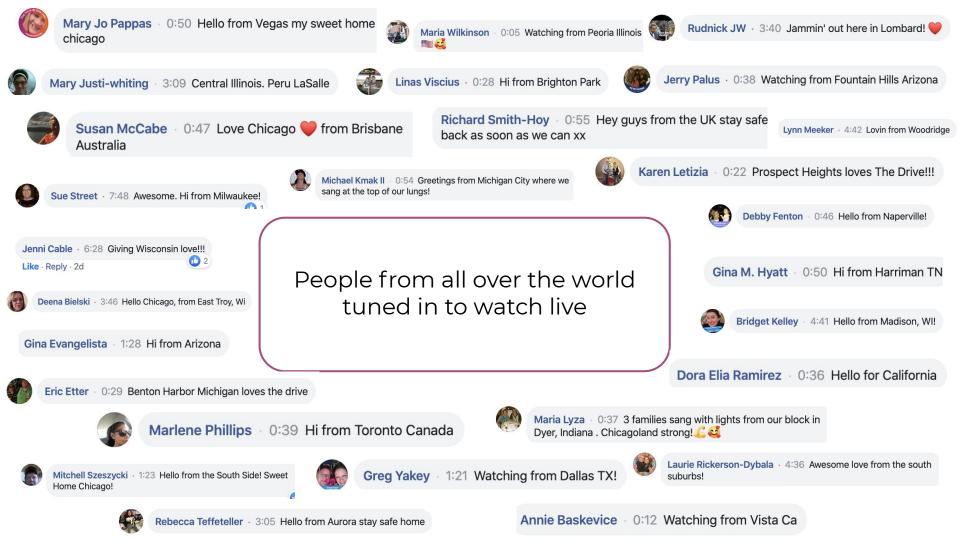

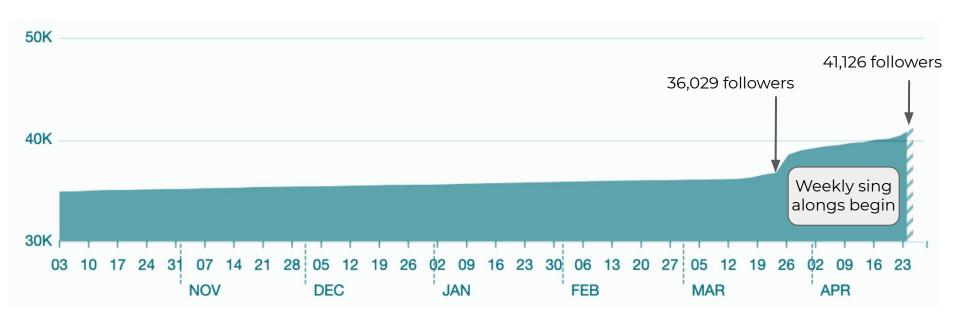
